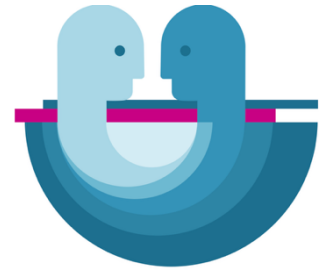


English Track at the German Psychotherapy Congress #DPK2026 – Connect Globally June 9-12, 2026
